

A Walk Through the Middle Ages

Welcome to the Middle Ages!

The goal of this special day is to have your students take a “Walk Through the Middle Ages” by visiting student created presentations that share information that the La Colina students have researched for the past month. This is a unique opportunity for your students to learn interesting information in an interactive way.

1. If coming on a bus provided by La Colina, check the website ahead of time to verify the schedule of the bus pick-up and drop-off times.
2. Prior to coming to La Colina arrange students in groups of 10 with one parent or teacher assigned to each group.
3. Groups must stay together.
4. When you arrive at La Colina, please go to the Welcome Booth and get a “Walk” program with a map of the scenes.
5. All presentations are between 5-7 minutes in long. **Be sure student groups stay together and STAY for the duration of the presentation.** Have students say thank you when the presentation is finished.
6. There is no scene that you need to start at. The “Walk” presentations have been set-up so you can start anywhere in the west parking lot and walk in any direction and see scenes from around the world.
7. We encourage teachers to fill out the comment form located in the program and leave it at the welcome booth on your way out. This feedback helps us make this event a better experience in the future.

This year we will have a few photo opportunities for the students. Students can take a picture in front of our medieval castle entrance, Viking boat, and with a medieval knight.
