## MY SEARCH: PART THREE

### Directions Sheet

**Objective:** In Part 3 you will report on your research and what you learned about your topic. This is the main part of your My Search.

- You will write a thesis statement that will then be supported by all the information gathered while doing research in the library or online.
- Your thesis statement should explain the main idea of your topic.
- You will then write the details of what you found while doing research to support your thesis statement.

#### Introduction (One paragraph/ 5 sentences)

- **Title (Hook):** Hook your audience's attention with a *catchy* introductory sentence about your topic.
- **Thesis Statement:** \_\_\_\_\_ was (were) important to the history of \_\_\_\_\_ (place/ society/ culture) because \_\_\_\_\_.
- **Blueprint:** Explain what you are going to include in this part of your report. (What three main ideas you will be explaining?)

#### Body Paragraphs - What did you learn about your topic? (minimum 3 paragraphs)

- Report what you learned about your topic
- You need three (3) paragraphs
- Each paragraph needs a topic sentence
- Each paragraph should include three (3) to five (5) details/ pieces of evidence from your notes that support your topic sentence

#### Conclusion (at least one paragraph)

- Strive to answer this question: Why do you think this topic is important to our understanding of world history? What is the big idea of your topic?
