Visiting Schools Directions Guide

Prior to The Walk

- Verify bus schedule pick-up time and drop-off times.
- Please divide students into groups of 8-10 **PRIOR** to arriving at La Colina.
- Have one teacher / chaperone per group.
- Please have each teacher / parent chaperone read this Directions Guide
- Teachers / chaperones are encouraged to bring a camera to take pictures.
- When schools arrive they will be met by a Walk Greeter that will direct each school to start at a different starting area; **Area A, Area B or Area C.**
- Please see the attached map of where your school is to begin.

During The Walk

- Student groups **MUST** stay together with teacher / chaperone.
- Students are **NOT** allowed to just wander unsupervised.
- La Colina students will be teaching 5-7 minute presentations about different aspects of the Middle Ages. Elementary groups are expected to stay for the entire presentation and respectfully listen and participate if asked.
- It is very loud in the Walk Areas. Encourage students to move in close to the presentations. Questions are encouraged at the end of presentations.
- If you have problems or concerns please ask for Ed Gomez (La Colina Dean of Students) or a parent volunteer helper in that area holding a clipboard.

Leaving The Walk

- Please exit through the **Big Castle** in **Area A** to the bus pick up area.
- Busses will pick up visiting students where they dropped them off.
